Audition Information:

Our goal is to move everyone in and out of auditions as quickly as possible. The part you read does not necessarily reflect the part you are being considered for. Please list all your conflicts (band, sports, choir, other activities) on your audition form. Make sure your name, e-mail address, and phone numbers (home, work, cell) are clearly printed on the audition form. The directors will notify you by e-mail. If you do not check email on a daily basis, please let the directors know to contact you by phone. We will post the Cast list as soon as possible on the www.youngfootliters.org website.

Rehearsals:

Rehearsals will begin January 18, 2010, Monday through Friday evenings starting at 7:00 PM. The location of rehearsals will be at the Sycamore Mall next to Ben Franklin

Tech Week:

Tech Week begins February 28, 2010 and is mandatory. Please check your school schedules & other schedules to make sure you have no conflicts for this week.

Young Footliters Fees:

1. Membership Fee (paid yearly per family): \$30
This fee covers many costs including the storage space where all costumes, props, etc. are stored, insurance, mailings, maintaining our website, and other costs. Fee is not refundable.
2. Participation Fee (paid per play per child): \$50
This fee helps defray production costs associated with the play (script fees; costume and set expenses; publicity; theatre rental). If for some reason your actor drops from the play, the participation fee will be refunded as long as we are notified by October 28, 2009.
3. PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE ACTOR RECEIVES A SCRIPT. FEES CAN BE PAID AT THE PARENT MEETING HELD DURING THE FIRST REHEARSAL.

Drama/Theatre Classes:

It is Footliters' policy that everyone takes at least one drama class per year to be eligible for our shows.

Parent Meeting:

The "heart" of Young Footliters is the parents and we absolutely need each parent to help. This is what makes our shows so great for our young actors! There will be a parent/guardian information meeting during the first rehearsal. The goal of this meeting will be to collect necessary fees (see above) and to enlist your help in putting on the show. We will need parent/guardians who can help with costumes, make-up, backstage monitoring, ushering, and coordination of the cast strike party/potluck and director's gift.
